1. Choose at least five major works to discuss the idea and practice of exchange in medieval and sixteenth-century English literature. What are the continuities and/or discontinuities? (25%)
2. Use representative works to analyze the idea of place in seventeenth- and eighteenth-century English literature. Are there significant differences with or without reference to cultural and historical context? (25%)
3. Choose TWO of the three. (25% each)
 - (1) Evaluate the usefulness and limits of romantic poetry in developing an ecocritical awareness. Choose three major poems for elaboration and illustration.
 - (2) Consider *The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde* and *The Importance of Being Earnest*. How does each of the two works highlight London with its unique literary style?
 - (3) Discuss sex and crisis in W. B. Yeats' "Leda and the Swan," "Sailing to Byzantium," and T. S. Eliot's *The Waste Land*.
