Jurassic World, the fourth instalment of Steven Spielberg's *Jurassic Park* has proven to be a box office smash hit by raking in over \$1.2 billion in just two weeks. While audiences across the globe flock to see the show, critics are divided in their opinions. Some have pointed out serious flaws and loopholes in the sizzling new dinosaur flick. One of the major attacks is on the authenticity of the dinosaurs portrayed in the movie.

The keenly awaited Spielberg blockbuster has come in for criticism from dinosaur experts who claim the creatures depicted in the film are not in line with the latest research. Unlike the 1993 original, which was praised for its attention to detail and accuracy, the new film shows portrays its Tyrannosaurus Rex and Velociraptors all wrong. Darren Naish, a palaeontologist at Southampton University told *The Times*: "The original film showed dinosaurs that were not simply roaring, scaly monsters but were active, social, bird-like animals with dynamic bodies. Now, *Jurassic World* is simply a dumb monster movie and there has been a deliberate effort to make its animals look different from the way we think they should." Research now shows pretty conclusively that the T-Rex and the Velociraptor would have had FEATHERS.
